Aditya Birla Hospital to launch emergency centre

Pimpri-based hospital to start centre at Chakan today

Pune: Pimpri-based Aditya Birla Memorial Hospital will launch its first emergency centre at Chakan on August 12. Spread over an area of more than 1,500 sq ft, the Emergency Centre is located near Chakan Chowk adjacent to the Nashik highway.

"Chakan is an industrial area where there is no tertiary healthcare facility available nearby and the people over there find it difficult to reach out to us for quality treatment as we are located far from that area.

OPERATIONAL 24X7

- Aditya Birla Emergency Centre will be operational 24X7, with a pharmacy and sample collection facility that will also be open 24 hours.
- Spread over an area of more than 1,500 sq ft, the Emergency Centre is located near Chakan Chowk adjacent to the Nashik highway.

Hence, we decided to launch this centre at Chakan," said Rekha Dubey, COO of the hospital.

The centre is equipped with well-trained medical and paramedical staff to

stabilise all types of medical emergency cases. Patients requiring further treatment after stabilisation would be shifted to the hospital for further management by specialists.
